Sir,

With due respect, I have the honour to report that today i.e 08/06/2020 at @ 3pm while I was at NAB-Office, one of my source men came and reported to me that two young tribal women, namely, i) Kimboi Haokip @ Kim about 30 yrs of Zionveng Moreh Ward No.7, P.S – Moreh, Tengnoupal District a/p Langol Type-2 near Jeep parking, P.S – Lamphel, Imphal West District and ii) Vavah Taothang about 36 yrs of Geljang village, P.S – Moirang, Churachandpur District a/p Langol Type-2 near Jeep parking, P.S – Lamphel, Imphal West District were going to transport some quantities of heroin No.4 powder for selling purpose in and around Gamnom Sapermeina Bazar area along Imphal - Dimapur road (NH-2). Accordingly, after verifying the veracity of the source report, I have recorded the statement of the source person and reduced in writing and submitted a similar copy of it to SP/NAB, Manipur for his kind information. I was not able to obtain a Search Authorization from the competent authority as the culprit has high chances of concealing the drugs and escaping from us. Immediately, I along with my police team of NAB-PS including women police and the source person with necessary equipments under the supervision of OC/NAB-PS rushed towards Gamnom Sapermeina Bazar along NH-2. At about 4:30 pm of the day, while we reached at in front of waiting shed of Gamnom Sapermeina Bazar Board, our source man indicated the two women carrying ladies hanging bags who were seen standing near the waiting shed of Gamnom Sapermeina Bazar Board. On seeing that, our police team rushed towards the two suspected women and detained them there at the spot for checking and verification while my source has been whisked away from the scene. Then, I disclosed our identities to the detainee as police personnel of NAB-PS, Manipur. On verification, the two detainees disclosed their identities as i) Kimboi Haokip @ Kim (30) yrs W/o Thangboi Haokip of Zionveng Moreh Ward No.7, P.S – Moreh, Tengnoupal District a/p Langol Type-2 near Jeep parking, P.S – Lamphel, Imphal West District, Manipur and ii) Vavah Taothang (36) yrs W/o Thangboi Taothang of Geljang village, P.S – Moirang, Churachandpur District a/p Langol Type-2 near Jeep parking, P.S – Lamphel, Imphal West District, Manipur. Then I called upon two civil persons who were available at the spot and requested them as to be stood as witnesses while I perform some legal formalities after disclosing my identity to them. Accordingly, the two witnesses also agreed to my request. Then, in presence of the two witnesses, I informed the two detainees one by one about the provisions of Section 50 ND&PS Act verbally as well as in writing and read out with Manipuri local language so as to made her understand about their legal right of searching their personal search as well as their belongings in presence of a magistrate or a gazette officer since they were suspected to

have possessed some narcotic drugs. On that, the two detainees opined to search their personal search one by one in presence of civil independent witnesses by woman police. Then, I recorded their option statements one by one and reduced in writing and read out with Manipuri local language so as to made her understand. Then, in presence of the two witnesses, I informed the woman police, namely, W/PC No. 0916579 Nirmala Gurung of NAB-PS to conduct the two body search of the two detainees one by one in presence of the witnesses at the secluded place of the spot. While conducting their body search in presence of the witnesses no incriminating articles were found but on checking their belongings i.e, one ladies hanging bag carried by the detainee, Kimboi Haokip @ Kim, 36 numbers of soap caps of different colours (Red-15, Blue-7, Pink-3, Green- 8 and Red-green mix -3) having similar shapes and sizes were found inside the said ladies hanging bag. On further opening of those 36 soap caps were found containing transparent plastic packets containing some whitish reddish powder substances suspected to be heroin powder. Then, I marked all the 36 soap caps containing suspected heroin powder as "A1", "A2",.....to "A36" for identification. Then, I took out a pinch of suspected heroin powder from each packet and conducted testing with the help of Field Testing Kit in presence of the witnesses and found positive result for No.4 Heroin powder. Further, I conducted the weighing of the suspected Heroin Powder one by one from each packets and found weighed 12 grams each i.e. $(12 \times 36) = 432$ grams in total including the weight of the plastic packets container. Then I put all the detected 36 packets of suspected No.4 Heroin powder inside one big size transparent plastic packet and randomly mixed together and marked as "B" for identification. Then, I drew out 10 grams of suspected No.4 Heroin powder from the packet marked as "B" and divided into two equal parts i.e 5 grams each and inserted inside two small plastic packets (transparent) and heated tightly and later I put inside two yellow paper envelopes and properly packed and sealed with wax and facsimile seal of OC/NAB-PS, Manipur and marked as B₁ and B₂ as original and duplicate samples respectively. Then, the remaining 422 grams of suspected Heroin Powder containing in big transparent plastic packet is re-packed by heating and put inside a carton box along with the 36 numbers of empty soap caps with all the 36 plastic packet containers inside the carton box were packed with white cloths and sealed with wax of OC/NAB-PS, Manipur and marked as B as parent exhibit. On initial questioning, the detainee namely, Kimboi Haokip @ Kim revealed that the detected drugs belongs to her and the same were brought for selling purpose. At 5.00 pm of the day, I have seized the detected 432 gms. of suspected No.4 Heroin powder along with one Mobile Handset MI Redmi 6 Pro model (smart phone) containing one SIM card of Airtel bearing phone no. 8732052251 from the possession of Kimboi Haokip @ Kim (30) yrs W/o Thangboi Haokip of Zionveng Moreh Ward No.7, P.S – Moreh, Tengnoupal District a/p Langol Type-2 near Jeep parking, P.S – Lamphel, Imphal West District, Manipur in presence of the civil witnesses by preparing a formal weighing & seizure memo at the spot. Further, at 5:15 pm of the day, I have seized one Mobile Handset Nokia 106 model (manual keypad) black in colour containing two SIM cards, i.e. i) Airtel Sim bearing phone no. 9862838434 and ii) Idea SIM bearing phone no. 9089345212 from the possession of Vavah Taothang (36) yrs W/o Thangboi Taothang of Geljang village, P.S – Moirang, Churachandpur District a/p Langol Type-2 near Jeep parking, P.S – Lamphel, Imphal West District, Manipur in presence of the civil

witnesses by preparing a formal seizure memo at the spot. Further, Later at 5:30 pm, the detainee namely, Kimboi Haokip @ Kim (30) yrs W/o Thangboi Haokip of Zionveng Moreh Ward No.7, P.S – Moreh, Tengnoupal District a/p Langol Type-2 near Jeep parking, P.S – Lamphel, Imphal West District, Manipur was arrested by furnishing an arrest memo in presence of the two witnesses. Further, at 5.35 pm the detainee namely, Vavah Taothang (36) yrs W/o Thangboi Taothang of Geljang village, P.S – Moirang, Churachandpur District a/p Langol Type-2 near Jeep parking, P.S – Lamphel, Imphal West District, Manipur was also arrested by furnishing an arrest memo in presence of the witnesses. I further obtained the signatures of the accused and the two civil witnesses on the information statements, option statements, weighing & seizure memo, seizure memo, arrest memos, on the original and duplicate and parent exhibits and all the relevant documents in which I also put my signatures on the same.

Thereafter, the arrested persons along with the seized articles were brought at NAB-PS with a written report and handed over to OC/NAB-PS for taking up necessary legal actions as per provision of law.
