Subject : Report



Sir,

I have the honour to state that today i.e. 13/06/2020 at about 4:10 pm, a routine checking was conducted by a Team of NAB PS including woman PCs, at Mantripukhri, under the supervision of SP, NAB PS and Addl. SP, NAB PS. It is pertinent to mention here that while conducting such checking, testing kits, weighing scale, and other required materials such as packing materials etc. are taken with the team in case of any chance recovery.

1. That, while checking the commuters, one lady who was carrying a gunny bag was detained for body search and checking. She was identified as Chaili Newme, 47 yrs, D/o Samuite U Newme, R/o Magulong Tamenglong, Manipur, A/P- Mantripukhri, Mercy Lane. She was searched and checked by observing formalities (information about body search, option statement for search in which she opted to search in presence of two independent witnesses which is reduced to writing).
2. That, during the search 35 (thirty five) Nos. of Caps of different colours were found inside the gunny bag (i.e. green-5, blue-8, red-14 and pink-8), which are marked from 1 to 35. Further, on checking the Caps are found to contain suspected Heroin in a transparent polythene bag. Accordingly, each polythene bag is preliminarily tested with the testing kit that shows positive results of Heroin.
3. That, by observing formalities the 35 (thirty five) polythene bags that contained Heroin is weighed and found that each bag weighs 13(thirteen) grams which altogether weighs 455(four hundred and fifty) grams, including the weight of transparent polythene bags.
4. That, the 35 bags that contains suspected Heroin powder is randomly mixed and put altogether in a transparent polythene bag and marked 'B'. From the very bag marked 'B', 10 grams is extracted and further divided into two equal halves i.e. 5 grams each and packed in two transparent polythene bags which are marked as 'A1' and 'A2' ('A1' as original exhibit and 'A2' as duplicate exhibit). Exhibits 'A1' and 'A2' are then put in separate yellow envelope which are sealed with wax under facsimile seal of OC/NAB-PS, Manipur.
5. That, the remaining 445 (four hundred and forty five) grams of suspected heroin powder, 35 empty soap caps and 35 empty polythene bags are put and packed in a carton box which is properly stitched and packed in a white cloth. The packed is then sealed with wax under facsimile seal of OC/NAB-PS, Manipur and marked 'A' as parent exhibit. Thus, the detected 455 grams of suspected Heroin powder is seized by observing formalities at 5:15 pm from the possession of Chaili Newme, 47 yrs, D/o Samuite U Newme, R/o Magulong Tamenglong, Manipur, A/P- Mantripukhri, Mercy Lane.
6. That, further, on production by Chaili Newme, one black coloured lady purse containing one Samsung Mobile Handset having IMEI Nos. 354721116874234 / 01 and 354721116874232 /

01, one AADHAAR Card bearing No. 2081 4640 1644 and a sum of Rs. 2340/- (two thousand three hundred and forty) only, are also seized by observing formalities at 5:25 pm. Chaili Newme, 47 yrs, D/o Samuite U Newme, R/o Magulong Tamenglong, Manipur, A/P- Mantripukhri, Mercy Lane is then arrested at 5:30 pm by observing formalities.

7. That, on preliminary questioning of Chaili Newme, 47 yrs, D/o Samuite U Newme, R/o Magulong Tamenglong, Manipur, A/P- Mantripukhri, Mercy Lane, she revealed that the suspected Heroin powder was handed over to her by one Felina of Churachandpur. She (Chaili Newme) further stated that Felina of Churachandpur is nearby around at Mantripukhri.
8. That, a search is immediately conducted in and around Mantripukhri and in that one White Bolero having R/No MN-02C/0023, as pointed out by Chaili Newme, is halted at Mantripukhri near Pukhri Achouba. There were two occupants in the Bolero and on preliminary questioning of the occupants of the Bolero, the two occupants identified themselves as (i) Felina Neinunne, 28 yrs, D/o Demkhokai, R/o Tuibong, Churachandpur, Manipur and (ii) Ngamkhomang Haokip, 30 yrs, S/o Janggin Haokip, R/o S. Muoldung Village, Churachandpur, Manipur.
9. That, by observing formalities both Felina Neinunne and Ngamkhomang Haokip, in presence of independent witnesses, are searched. In that, one black coloured lady hand bag containing a sum of Rs. 4,00,000/- (four lakhs), one OPPO mobile phone handset having IMEI No. 862225041698432 and 862225041698424, and one Aadhaar card having No. 5465 9121 3009 were recovered from the possession of Felina Neinunne, 28 yrs, D/o Demkhokai, R/o Tuibong, Churachandpur, Manipur, which are seized at 7:25 pm in presence of witnesses. She is then, arrested at 7:30 pm.
10. Further, Ngamkhomang Haokip, 30 yrs, S/o Janggin Haokip, R/o S. Muoldung Village, Churachandpur, Manipur is also arrested at 7:45 pm, and from his possession the Bolero bearing R/No. MN-02C/0023, one leather wallet (black colour) containing Registration card of the Bolero that stands in the name of Paolam Haokip, one Driving Licence bearing No. DL. No. 111317/Ch and a sum of Rs 570/- (five hundred and seventy), one Oppo mobile phone handset having IMEI No. 860527048069695 and 8605270458069687, are seized at 7:50 pm, by observing formalities.
11. Thereafter, the seized articles along with the arrested persons and relevant documents along with a written report, are handed over to you for taking up further necessary action as per provision of law.
