Subject: - Report

Sir,

I have the honour to report that today i.e. 01/02/2018 at around 04:30 pm received a credible information from our own source regarding selling of illegal drugs like SP capsules, WY tablets, Cough syrup bottles etc. at the house of Mrs. Itomcha aged about 54 years W/O (L) Md. Rashid Ahamed and Md. Abdul Hakim S/O (L) Rashid Ahamed of Lilong Haorou Hangamthabi. Then I quickly recorded his statement in writing and a similar copy of the writing has been sent to superior officers. Then, two teams of Lilong Police Station led by OC Lilong PS assisted by myself and ASI Laishram Tikendro of Lilong PS rushed to the said houses and strictly cordoned the houses. I called out the family members of the house of Mrs. Itomcha in that one woman who identified herself as one Mrs. Itomcha aged about 54 years W/O (L) Md. Rashid Ahamed came out of the house. Then I informed her that our police team would like to search of her house in the presence of witnesses. With her consent I along with police team started to search the house in presence of the civil witnesses. On searching the house found one black colour polythene containing some substances kept concealed inside the blanket of her bed. On opening the black colour polythene found (i) one blue colour packet suspected to be WY tablets, (ii) blue colour cylindrical capsules suspected to be Spasmo Proxyvon capsules and (iii) 5 nos. of Cough syrup bottles marked as "Lupikof-DX". On counting the suspected WY tablets found 97 (Ninety Seven) nos. and the suspected SP capsules count 547 (five hundred forty seven) nos. On weighing the said suspected WY tablets by the weighing machine brought by us, it weighs 10.7 grams and the suspected SP capsules weighs 353.3 grams. Out of the 97 nos. of the suspected WY tablets 20 nos. of the same tablets were taken out and put inside two yellow envelopes with 10 nos. of the same tablets each, packed and sealed and marked as "A1" and "A2" as original and duplicate sample respectively. And the remaining 77 nos. of the same tablets were put inside the blue colour polythene and again put inside another yellow envelope packed and sealed and marked as "A" as Parent sample exhibit. Further out of the 547 nos. of suspected SP capsules, 20 nos. of the same capsules were taken out and put inside two yellow envelopes with 10 nos. of the same capsules each, packed and sealed and marked as "B1" and "B2" as original and duplicate sample respectively. And the remaining 527 nos. of the same tablets were put inside the blue colour polythene and again put inside another yellow envelope packed and sealed and marked as "B" as Parent sample exhibit. Again out of the 5 nos. of Cough syrup bottles 2 nos. were taken out and put inside one yellow envelope and marked as "C1" as original sample exhibit after properly packed and sealed. And the remaining 3 nos. of the said cough syrup bottles were put inside another yellow envelope, packed and sealed and marked as "C" as parent sample exhibit.

Therefore the packed and sealed drugs were seized from the unauthorized possession of Mrs. Itomcha aged about 54 years W/O (L) Md. Rashid Ahamed of Lilong Haorou Hangamthabi at 06:25 pm by preparing formal weighing and seizure memo in the presence of the civil witnesses and later arrested her on the spot at 06:35 pm.

Further, I moved on to the next house i.e. the house of Md. Abdul Hakim S/O (L) Rashid Ahamed of Lilong Haorou Hangamthabi. I called out the family members of the house in that one person who identified himself as one Md. Neeraj (18) S/O Md. Abdul Hakim. I informed him that I would like to conduct search of his house. With his consent I started to search his house in the presence of civil witnesses. On searching his house found 3 nos. of Cough syrup bottles containing codeine phosphate marked as "KOF-T" and 4 nos. of Cough syrup bottles marked as "Codylate" at the upper side of the wooden cupboard of the house. The 3 nos. of cough syrup bottles marked as "KOF-T" is put inside yellow envelope, packed and sealed and marked as "D1" as original sample exhibit. And out of the 4 nos. of cough syrup bottles 2 nos. of the same bottles were put inside two yellow envelope packed and sealed and marked as "E1" as original sample exhibit and the remaining 2 nos. of the same bottles were put inside another yellow envelope packed and sealed and marked as "E" as parent sample exhibit.

Hence the packed and sealed drugs were seized from the unauthorised possession of Md. Neeraj (18) S/O Md. Abdul Hakim of Lilong Haorou Hangamthabi in the presence of the civil witnesses by preparing a formal seizure memo at 06:50 pm. Further arrested the said person at 07:00 pm.

Thus all the arrested accused persons and the seized drugs were brought to Lilong Police Station and handed over to you for further necessary legal actions.
