On 07/02/2019 at around 08:00 pm received information from my own source regarding selling of illegal drugs i.e. SP capsules at the house of Md. Arif (25) S/O Md. Salaoddin @ Aku of Lilong Haoreibi Awang Leikai Tera Makhong. Then I recorded his statement in writing and a similar copy of the same has been sent to the Superior Officer. Immediately, two teams of Lilong PS led by myself assisted by SI Md. Islauddin and ASI Laishram Tikendro of Lilong PS including Women PCs along with some volunteers of All Lilong Anti-Drug Association (ALADA) rushed to the said house without obtaining search authorization as there was a great chance of escaping of offenders and concealing the drugs. On reaching the house of Md. Arif, the police team cordoned the house and called out the family members of the house. In that one lady who identified herself as Mrs. Gaho aged about 52 years came out of the house. Then I informed her that our police team would like to search her house. With her consent our police team including Women PCs started to search her house. When our police team entered inside the room of Md. Arif (as identified by Mrs. Gaho), one lady later identified as Miss Peku 27 yrs. D/o Md. Salaoddin of Lilong Haoreibi Awang Leikai Tera Makhong came out from the room of Md. Arif by holding a nylon bag in a very suspicious manner. Our team detained her and gave her option that I would like to conduct her body search by our Women PCs. Further, I asked whether she like to conduct her body search in presence of Gazetted Officer/Magistrate or not. In that she opted that she liked her body to be searched by our Women Police personnel not before Gazetted Officer or Magistrate. With her consent, two lady police personnel namely WHC Steny Maring and WPC No. 1208104 Mrs. Rahamjan Begum conducted body search. In that detected one white colour transparent polythene containing blue colour cylindrical capsules suspected to be Spasmo Proxyvon capsules from her inner cloth. On counting the suspected SP capsules, it is found 288 nos. of suspected SP capsules in the white colour transparent polythene.

On opening the nylon bag found blue colour cylindrical capsules suspected to be Spasmo Proxyvon capsules. On counting the suspected SP capsules in the presence of the civil witnesses, found 11,186 (eleven thousand one hundred eighty six) nos. of suspected SP capsules. On weighing the said drugs, it weighs 7.411 Kg.


Therefore the said lady who identified herself as Miss Peku (27) D/O Md. Salaoddin @ Aku of Lilong Haoreibi Awang Leikai Tera Makhong was arrested on the spot at 09:30 pm. In the meantime, while we tried to packed the said drugs under the procedures of ND & PS Act, many locals came out of their houses and started to obstruct the police to continue the procedures. Also they pelted stones and thus started organizing a mob and trying to snatch the arrested lady. However, our police team very wisely tackled the mob and managed to come out of the situation.

Thus our police team arrived at the PS at 10:15 pm and continued to packed and sealed under the procedures of ND & PS Act. Then out of the 288 nos. of suspected SP capsules, 20 nos. of the same capsules were taken out and put 10 nos. of the same capsules each in two yellow envelopes, packed and sealed and marked as "A1", "A2" as original and duplicate sample exhibits respectively. And the remaining 268 nos. of the same is put inside another yellow envelope packed and sealed and marked "A" as Parent sample exhibits.

Similarly, out of the 11,186 (eleven thousand one hundred eighty six) nos. of suspected SP capsules 20 nos. of the same capsules were taken out and put 10 nos. of the same capsules each in two yellow envelopes, packed and sealed and marked as "B1", "B2" as original and duplicate sample exhibits respectively. And the remaining 11,166 (eleven thousand one hundred sixty six) nos. of the same suspected SP capsules were put inside the original nylon bag and wrapped with white packed and sealed and marked "B" as Parent sample exhibits.

Therefore, the packed and sealed drugs were seized by observing formalities at 11:50 pm in the presence of civil witnesses. Hence a Suo Motto case under FIR No. 23(02)2019 LIL PS U/S 21(c)/25/29 ND & PS Act is registered for investigation.
