

Today Le 15/02/2018 at about 05.10 pm, two teams of Lilong PS led by myself assisted by SI Md. Islauddin and ASI Laishram Mukesh of Lilong PS including Women PCs along conducting frisking and checking at Lilong Bazar area near the bridge. In the meantime one person was found coming on foot from Lilong Bazar side towards Imphal side in very suspicious manner. On seeing our police team, the person tried escape from said area and then our team tactically stop there and detained him at spot for further verification. On verification he identified himself as Khuraijam Langamba (24) S/o (L) KH. Ningthem of Khagempali Nganapi Thong and gave him an option that I would like to conduct his body search by our team and asked him whether he like to conduct his body search in presence of Gazetted Officer/Magistrate/civil witnesses or not. In that he opted that he liked to conduct his body search by our team in presence of civil witnesses. Then, I called some members of ALADA (All Lilong Anti Drug Association) through mobilephone. After some minutes, some members of ALADA arrived at the spot, our team started body search of him in presence of civil witnesses. On body search, a black small polythene bag was found from the left side pocket of his pant. Further, on opening the said polythene bag, found some blue colour cylindrical capsules suspected to be SP-Capsules (Spasmo proxybon). On counting, we found 55 nos. of blue colour cylindrical capsules from his possession and on weighing it weight 35 grams including the weight of polythene. Then out of the 55 nos. of suspected SP capsules, 20 nos. of the same capsules were taken out and put 10 nos. of the same capsules each in two yellow envelopes, packed and sealed and marked as "A1", "A2" as original and duplicate sample exhibits respectively. And the remaining 22 nos. of the same is put inside another yellow envelope packed and sealed and marked "A" as Parent sample exhibits. Therefore, the said person was arrested at spot at 05.35 pm and seized blue capsules suspected to be SP- capsules at the spot at 5.40 pm by preparing formal weighing and seizure memo.

On spot interrogation of the said arrested person, I came to know that he has been doing such illegal drugs business with his associate one of his friend namely Achom Ricky (30) S/o A. Tikendrajit Singh of Sagolband Bijoy Govinda who was awaiting for him at Singjamei Yunam Leikai just opposite of Oilpum. Immediately, our team went to the said area along with the arrested person (Khuraijam Langamba) and arrested him (Achom Ricky) from Singjamei Yunam Leikai at 6.15 pm.


On spot interrogation of the said arrested persons namely A. Ricky and Ak. Lamnganba, I came to know that the seized SP-Capsules were brought from one Md. Allimudin (30) S/O (L) Md. Nasiruddin of Lilong Tairen Makhong. Accordingly, I along with our team including some members of ALADA rushed at the house of Md. Allimudin at Lilong Tairen makhong. On reaching the house of Md. Alimuddin, one woman was coming out from the house and other 03 persons were found at the courtyard of the house and they were tried to flee away when our police team were entering to the said house. Our team pursued them quickly and detained for verification. On verification, the woman identified herself as one Mrs. Sahila @ Baby (24) yrs. W/o Md. Alimuddin of Lilong Tairen Makhong. Then I asked her by giving an option to conduct her body search in presence of a Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer. In that she opined to conduct body search in presence of civil witnesses. Subsequently our women police conducted body search and found one yellow polythene from her possession inside her inner cloth. On opening the yellow polythene bag we found one white colour polythene bag marked as "Amazon" and one black colour polythene carry bag. On opening the said white and black colour polythene bags, we found some blue colour cylindrical capsules suspected to be SP- Capsules (Spasmo proxyvon) and white colour tablets suspected to be N-10 tablets (Nitrosun-10) inside the polythene bags respectively. On counting, we found 1147 nos. of blue colour capsules suspected to be SP-Capsules and it weight 729.91 grams and 500 nos. of white tablets suspected to be N-10 tablets and it weight 350 grams including the weight of polythene. Then out of the 1147 nos. of suspected SP capsules, 20 nos. of the same capsules were taken out and put 10 nos. of the same capsules each in two yellow envelopes, packed and sealed and marked as "B1", "B2" as original and duplicate sample exhibits respectively. And the remaining 1127 nos. of the same is put inside another yellow envelope packed and sealed and marked "B" as Parent sample exhibits and out of the 500nos. of suspected N-10 tablets, 20 nos. of the same capsules were taken out and put 10 nos. of the same capsules each in two yellow envelopes, packed and sealed and marked as "C1", "C2" as original and duplicate sample exhibits respectively. And the remaining 480 nos. of the same is put inside another yellow envelope packed and sealed and

marked "C" as Parent sample exhibits. Then, she was arrested at spot at 6.55 pm and seized the said illegal drugs from her possession at 7.05 pm by observing all formalities.

On further verification of other 03 persons, they identified themselves as 1) Md. Momin (26) S/O (L) Md. Tomba of Lilong Tairen Makhong 2) Md. Afijal (29) S/o Md. Maneruddin of Lilong Uku Mamang and 3) Md. Rafique Khan (27) S/O (L) Md. Helaluddin of Lilong Tolengkun and then I asked them by giving an option to conduct their body search in presence of a Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer. In that they opined to conduct body search in presence of civil witnesses. In that detected one black colour polythene bag containing blue colour cylindrical capsules suspected to be Spasmo Proxyvon capsules from one of the person namely Md. Momin (26) S/O (L) Md. Tomba of Lilong Tairen Makhong. On counting the suspected SP capsules, it is found 60 nos. of suspected SP capsules inside the black colour polythene bag. On weighing, it weight 38.18 grams including the weight of polythene and then out of the 60 nos. of suspected SP capsules, 20 nos. of the same capsules were taken out and put 10 nos. of the same capsules each in two yellow envelopes, packed and sealed and marked as "D1", "D2" as original and duplicate sample exhibits respectively. And the remaining 40 nos. of the same is put inside another yellow envelope packed and sealed and marked "D" as Parent sample exhibits and also no any articles were found from the possession of other two persons namely Md. Afijal and Md. Rafique Khan. However, on further verification, they stated that they were staying at the house to take the illegal drug for their consumption. Then, they were arrested at the spot at 7.25 pm and seized the said illegal drugs at 7.30 pm by observing all formalities in presence of the witnesses.

Therefore, the packed and sealed seized illegal drugs and the arrested persons were brought at our Ps. Hence a Suo- Motto case under **FIR No. 25(02)2019 LIL. PS U/S 21(c)/22(b)/27/29 ND & PS Act** is registered for investigation.
