Today i.e, 08/03/2019 at around 4.30 pm while I was in the office of Lilong PS, received a reliable information from one of my source that one lady namely Mrs. Sakila aged about 26 yrs. W/o Md. Babu of Lilong Haoreibi Turel Ahanbi Darul Uloom Makha is selling SP (Spas Prime Von) capsules at her house. After verifying the veracity of the source report, I recorded the information in writing and a copy of the said report was furnished to SP/ Thoubal for information. Immediately, I along with police team assisted by ASI. Md. Ajahar Ali of Lilong PS rushed to the said place without obtaining search authorization as there was great chance of escaping of offenders and concealing the drugs. At about 5.45 pm of the same day, we reached at her house, a lady was found standing at the courtyard and as soon as she saw our police team, she hurriedly ran inside her house through front main door. Immediately our police team cordoned the house. After 2/3 minutes the lady who ran inside the house came out of the house through back side door along with one black polythene bag in her hand. But on sawing our police team she (Mrs. Sakila) suddenly threw away the polythene bag and fled away from the spot. Our police team chased her but she managed to escape by taking advantage of the darkness. On opening the black polythene bag before the civil witnesses, found 1770(one thousand seven hundred and seventy) Nos blue colour SP (Spas-primevon) capsules in the black polythene bag. On weighing of one capsule, it weighs 0.61gm i.e. altogether $(1770 \times 0.61) = 1079.7$ gms. Out of which 10(ten) capsules were taken out and 5(five) capsule each packed in two yellow envelope as Exhibit marked as "S1" and "S2" as original and duplicate sample respectively. The remaining 1760(one thousand seven hundred and sixty) capsules were put inside the transparent polythene plastic bag, then packed it inside a yellow envelope marked as "S" as parent exhibit. The exhibits marked as S1, S2 & S were sealed with wax in presence of the witnesses and seized the exhibits at 6.20 pm of the same day from the spot by observing formality.

Hence, a suo-motto case under FIR No 32(03)2019 LIL-PS, U/S 21(c) ND & PS Act has been registered for investigation.
