On 11/03/2019 at about 11:00 pm as part of the preventive measure taken up in connection with the ensuing Lok Sabha Election, 2019, Police team of District, Thoubal comprising of Lilong Police Station team and Police Commando, Thoubal led by Inspt. O. Ajit Singh, OC, Lilong PS assisted by SI Md. Wakibuddin, SI Kh. Santosh Singh, ASI Md. Ajahar Ali of Lilong PS, SI Rameeh Singh of CDO/TBL and HC Athokpam Rajeshwor Singh of CDO/TBL under the supervision of SI/TBL conducted patrolling in the jurisdiction of Lilong PS. At about 11:45 pm of the day, when our Police teams arrived at Chingkhram Mamang Leikai, found one Maruti Alto Car B/Rgd. No. MN06LA-7132 and one Honda Dio B/Rgd. No. MN01AE-6447 parked at the roadside of IVR of Lilong Chingkhram Hangamthabi road crossing in a suspicious manner. As our police teams approached near the vehicles, five individuals came out of the Alto car and tried to flee away. One of them was holding one polythene carry bag orange in colour. Our teams managed to detain all of them at the spot for verification. On verification, they identified themselves as (1) VDF No. V113194 Md. Ferosh Khan (23) yrs, S/o. Md. Fajuruddin of Paobitek Mamang Leikai, Imphal West, posted at Reserve Line, District Police Imphal West (the person holding one polythene carry bag orange in colour) (2) Md. Akhan (30) yrs, S/o. (L) Jalaruddin of Paobitek Mamang Leikai, Imphal West (3) VDF No. 0901084 Md. Najir Ahamed (22) yrs, S/o. Md. Tomba of Paobitek Mamang Leikai, Imphal West, posted at Reserve Line, District Police Imphal West (4) VDF No. V112888 Md. Anish Khan (24) yrs, S/o. Md. Ayub Khan of Paobitek Mamang Leikai, Imphal West, posted at Reserve Line, District Police Imphal West & (5) Md. Nawaj Khan (22) yrs, S/o. (L) Md. Abdur Rahim of Lilong Tairen Makhong. Being suspicious, we conducted search of the vehicles as well as their bodies in the absence of civil witnesses as there were none at the nearby area. On checking of the polythene bag which was hold by Md. Ferosh, found many pink colour tablets suspected to be WY (Amphetamine) tablets rubbed with transparent polythene carry bag. Accordingly, I intimated SP/TBL, namely Shri. Dr. S. Ibomcha Singh, MPS about the incident. Then, conducted counting of the WY tablets and found 9,800 (nine thousand eight hundred) tablets. On weighing, one tablet weighed 0.104 mg, altogether total tablets weighed 1.019 kgs. Then, the original transparent plastic polythene containing WY tablets is marked as W for identification. From W, extracted 20 Nos. of WY tablets put 10 Nos. of WY tablets each inside the two yellow envelop, packed and marked as W1 & W2 as representative samples (Original & Duplicate respectively). The remaining 9,780 (nine thousand seven hundred eighty) tablets were put inside the original transparent polythene carry bag, wrapped with white cloth, packed and marked as Was parent sample. The parent sample marked as W and representative samples marked as W1 & W2 were sealed with wax in presence of witnesses.

On preliminary examination, Md. Ferosh Khan stated that the above noted Maruti Alto car and WY tablets belong to him. He further stated that the same suspected WY tablets were handed over by Shri Radhakishore Wahengbam (36) yrs, S/o. Wahengbam Bhaskar Singh of Nongmeibung Chakpram Leikai, Imphal East who is presently serving as Sub Inspector in Manipur Police Department now posted at CID Security Section, currently attached with NAB, Manipur and one unknown person coming in one Silky Silver coloured Alto car with a condition to share the sale proceed of the suspected WY tablets. Accordingly, he contacted his three associates namely Md. Akhan, Md. Najir Ahamed & Md. Anish Khan and they conspired to sell the suspected WY tablets to Md. Nawaj Khan (22) yrs, S/o. (L) Md. Abdur Rahim of Lilong Tairen Makhong. On examination of Md. Akhan, Md. Nazir Ahamed & Md. Anish Khan, they all corroborated with the statement of Md. Ferosh Khan and Md. Akhan stated that the above noted Honda Dio belong to him. On examination of Md. Nawaj Khan, he also corroborated with the statements of aforesaid individuals and stated that he came there to buy the WY tablets which were brought by Md. Ferosh, Md. Akhan, Md. Najir Ahamed & Md. Anish Khan. So, the above noted 9,800 (nine thousand eight hundred) suspected WY tablets along with Maruti Alto car B/Rgd. No. MN06LA-7132 and Honda Dio B/Rgd. No. MN01AE-6447 was seized in presence of witnesses by preparing a formal seizure memos at 01:00 am of 12/03/2019. Also arrested the aforementioned five individuals from the spot by preparing formal arrest memos at 01:10 am of 12/03/2019. The approximate market value of the seized WY tablets is Rs. 500000/- (five lakhs).

On follow up action, as the immediate apprehension of Shri Radhakishore Wahengbam (36) yrs, S/o. Wahengbam Bhaskar Singh of Nongmeibung Chakpram Leikai, Imphal East was necessary, our police teams rushed to the house of Radhakishore Wahengbam (36) yrs, S/o. Wahengbam Bhaskar Singh of Nongmeibung Chakpram Leikai, Imphal East after informing Police Control Room (PCR), Imphal East District and arrested him from his house at 02:30 am of 12/03/2019. On asking he stated that the seized drugs was brought by one Laishram Sanjoy Singh S/o. (L) L. Yaima Singh of Luker Maning Leikai, Imphal West who is serving as Constable bearing C/No. 0901717 of Imphal East District Police, currently attached with NAB-PS, Manipur. He admitted that he together with Laishram Sanjoy Singh conspired to sell the seized drugs and accordingly, delivered the seized drugs to the aforementioned individual Md. Ferosh Khan and asked him to sell it out.

Hence, a suo motto case under FIR No. 33(03)2019 LIL-PS u/s- 22(c)/29/60(3) ND&PS Act has been registered for investigation.
