Sub:- Report.

Sir,


With due respect, I have the honour to report that today i.e 21/08/2019 at 4pm while I was at NAB-Office, One of my source men came and reported to me that one muslim woman namely Khusida aged about (25) yrs W/o (L) Md Akhtar of Lilong Atoukhong will be transporting some quantities of heroin No.4 for selling illegally in around Mayang Imphal Area along Mayai Lambi road. Accordingly, I have recorded the statement of the source person and reduced in writing and submitted a similar copy of it to SP/NAB, Manipur for kind information. I was not able to obtain a Search Authorization from the competent authority as the culprit has high chances of escaping from us. Immediately, I along with my police team of NAB-PS including the source person with necessary equipments under the supervision of OC/NAB-PS, rushed towards Mayang Imphal side. At about 4:30 pm of the day, we reached Thiyam Leishangkhong Khwai Leirak near Mayang Imphal. Then we followed the instructions of my source person and took positions alertly and kept watching for the woman by parking our official vehicles at nearby the main road heading towards Mayang Imphal side with maintaining some gap distance. Then after 30 minutes of awaiting it, one muslim woman was seen who just got down from one passenger auto with carrying a plastic polythene (black colour) in her hands coming from Mayang Imphal side. Then, immediately, under the instructions of my source, I and my team rushed to her place and detained her for checking and verification while my source has been whisked away from the scene. Then, I disclosed our identities to the detainee as police personnel of NAB-PS, Manipur. On verification the detainee disclosed herself as Khusida, aged a (25) yrs W/o (L) Md. Akhtar of Lilong Atoukhong, PS-I II., Dist. Thoubal, Manipur. Then I called up two civil persons who were present nearby there and requested them as to be stood as witnesses while I perform some legal formality after

disclosing my identity to them, accordingly the two also agreed to my request. Then, in presence of the two witnesses, I informed to the detainee the provisions of Section 50 ND&PS Act verbally as well as in writing about her legal right of searching her personal search as well as her belongings in presence of a magistrate or a gazette officer since she was suspected to have possessed some narcotic drugs. On that, the detainee opined to search his personal search along with his belongings in presence of civil independent witnesses. I also recorded her information's statements as well as her option statements and reduced in writing. Then, in presence of the two witnesses, I conducted her body search at the secluded place and found nothing but on checking of her belongings i.e. the black plastic polythene which she has been carrying it and found 15 soap caps of different colours (Red-5, Blue-3, Pink-4, Green- 1, Blue & Pink-1 and Red & green-1) having similar shapes and sizes inside the said plastic polythene and marked as "A" to "O" for identification. On further opening of those 15 (fifteen) soap caps, found containing some whitish reddish powder- which are suspected to be a heroin powder. Then, I took out a pinch of it in each packet and conducted testing with the help of Field Testing Kit in presence of the two witnesses and found a positive result for No.4 Heroin powder. On further weighing of the suspected Heroin Powder found weighing 255 grams in total including the plastic container. Then I put all the detected No.4 Heroin powder (suspected) inside one plastic packet and marked as "A" as parent exhibit then I drew out 10 grams from the parent exhibit and divided into two equal parts i.e 5 grams each and inserted inside two small plastic packets (transparent) and heated tightly and later I put inside two paper envelopes yellow colour and properly packed and sealed with wax and marked as A<sub>1</sub> and A<sub>2</sub> as original and duplicate samples respectively. The remaining 245 grams of suspected Heroin Powder was re-inserted into its original plastic container which was marked as A as parent exhibit and packed and sealed properly with wax. Then, the fifteen(15) empty soap caps including the small plastic packets were put inside a cartoon box, wrapped with a white cloth, packed and sealed with wax and marked as 'B'. At 5:00 pm of the day, I have seized the 255 gms. of suspected No.4 Heroin powder and one Mobile Handset Samsung keypad Blue black in colour containing one Airtel Sim bearing phone no. 8132011009 from the possession of Mrs. Khusida (25) yrs W/o (L) Md. Akhtar of Lilong Atoukhong, PS-LIL, Dist-Thoubal, Manipur in presence of the two civil witnesses by preparing a formal weighing & seizure memo at Thiyam Leishangkhong Khwai Leirak near Mayang Imphal. Later at 5:15 pm, the detainee was arrested by furnishing an arrest memo in presence of the two witnesses. I


further obtained signatures of the accused and the two civil witnesses on the weighing & seizure memo, arrest memo, on the exhibits and all the relevant documents in which I also put my signatures on the same.

Thereafter, the arrested person along with the seized articles were brought to NAB-PS with a written report and handed over to OC/NAB-PS for taking up necessary legal actions as per provision of law.
