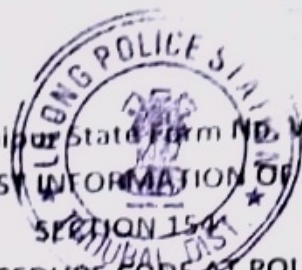


Sub:- Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that on 24/11/2019 at about 5:30 pm while I was at Lilong Police Station received reliable information that one drug peddler namely Md. Chinges (25) s/o Ismat Ali of Lilong Chandakhong Makok is selling illegal drugs such as illegal cough syrups, WY tablets (Amphetamine) at his house and some quantities of the said drugs are still kept concealed at his house. Accordingly, I recorded the information in writing and a copy of the same was furnished to my senior officer for information. Immediately, I along with Police Party rushed to the said place without obtaining search authorization as there was great chance of escape of the offender and concealing the drug. I also called upon some volunteers of All Lilong Anti-Drug Association (ALADA) at the place so as to witness the scene. On reaching at his house at about 6:00 pm of the day, on seeing the police team, one person ran away from the house throwing away one black colour polythene at his house itself. The Police team chased him but he managed to escape by taking advantages of darkness. Thereafter, I requested two persons available there to be witness while opening the black colour polythene carry bag. In presence of the witness I opened the polythene and found 17 bottles of Codylate cough syrup (100 ml each), 4 bottles of Lykarex cough syrup (100 ml each), 3 bottles of MACODIN cough syrup (100 ml each) and 40 tablets of WY (Amphetamine). On checking each bottle of Codylate, Lykarex and MACODIN cough syrup contains 10 (ten) mg codeine phosphate per 5 ml each (as per composition) which is a contravened substance under ND&PS Act. On calculation/weighing, one bottle of cough syrup contained $10 \times 20 = 200$ mg of codeine (as per composition), altogether $200 \times 24 = 4,800$ mg. On weighing of the WY tablets, it weighed 4 grams. Then, extracted two bottles of Codylate cough syrup, put inside the two yellow envelopes separately, packed and marked as "A1" & "A2" as original & duplicate representative samples respectively. The remaining 15 bottles of Codylate cough syrup were put inside the original black colour polythene carry bag, wrapped with white cloth then packed it and marked as "A" as parent exhibit. Similarly, samples marked as B1, B2 & C1, C2 were drawn from Lykarex and MACODIN cough syrups respectively as original & duplicate representative samples respectively. The remaining 2 bottles of Lykarex and 1 bottle of MACODIN cough syrups were put inside the two yellow envelopes separately, packed it and marked as "B" & "C" as parent exhibits respectively. Again, extracted 20 tablets WY tablets, put 10 tablets of each inside two transparent polythene pouch, put inside the two yellow envelopes, packed and marked as "D1" & "D2" as original and duplicate representative samples respectively. The remaining 20 tablets WY tablets were put inside a blue colour polythene pouch, put inside a yellow envelop, packed and marked as "D" as parent exhibit. The exhibits marked as A1, A2, A, B1, B2, B, C1, C2, C, D1, D2 & D were sealed with wax in presence of the witnesses. Hence, seized the above mentioned articles at 6:40 pm of 24/11/2019 by observing formalities.

Hence, the seized articles are handed over to you further necessary action.
