Subject: Report

Sir,

With due respect, I have the honour to report that today i.e. 20/01/2020 at about 2.50 p.m. one of my source men came to me and informed that four persons were going to smuggle huge quantities of contraband drugs by using Maruti Swift Desire car(white in colour bearing regd. No. MN04P-1964) in an around the area of Sekmai near Zuko Hotel. Accordingly, I have recorded the statement of the source man in written and submitted a similar copy to SP/NAB, Manipur, for kind information and necessary action.

Immediately, I along with SI Kh. Bungcha Singh including women police and a team of NAB PS under the supervision of Add. SP, Shri Shaklemba Rajkumar and under all supervision of SP/NAB, Shri Watham Basu Singh rushed towards Sekmai area along the NH-2 with field testing kits and other necessary equipments without obtaining search order/authorization as there was great chance of escape of the persons and the drug. On reaching Sekmai, two suspected vehicles i.e. Maruti Swift Desire(white in colour) came towards Imphal side in a very suspicious manner. On seeing us, both the vehicles tried to escape by driving in a very high speed towards Sekmai Bazaar but our team chased the said vehicles and able to stop at Sekmai near Zuko Hotel and finally overpowered to detain them.

After identifying ourselves as police personnel of NAB-PS, I stop and requested two passer-by to stand as witnesses while conducting some legal procedures where they also voluntarily agreed. I found two persons each inside the two vehicles and detained them for verification in presence of the witnesses. On verification, the driver of the vehicle (Maruti Swift Desire bearing regd. No. NL 07C 7938), identified himself as K. Nipuni(29)yrs s/o Kaisii of Taphou Village, Senapati, P.S.- Senapati, Senapati-Dist, Manipur accompanied by other two persons namely, (i)Khajung Shakpa(30)yrs s/o Shakpa of Maram Khullen, Maram Makha Sagoi, PS: Mao, Senapati-Dist, Manipur and (ii)Mr. Damlian Osana(35) s/o Daiho Osana of Emesiiphro Village, PO & PS: Senapati, Dist-Senapati, Manipur. On verification of the other vehicle bearing regd. No. AS 01AR 9522(Maruti Desire), the driver identified himself as Letgin Chongloi(43)yrs s/o Paojahao Chongloi of Khomunnom Village, near Saikhul A/P Motbung Luikhoi Veng, PS: Kangpokpi, Dist-KPI, Manipur. I informed the four detainees as per section 50 of ND&PS Act, verbally as well as in writing about his legal right of searching his personal search as well as his belongings in presence of a magistrate or a gazetted officer since they were suspected to have possessed some narcotic drugs.

On that, the detainees opted to search their belongings and the vehicle in presence of civil independent witnesses. Option statements of the detainees were also recorded by me in writing and the same were also read out and translate into Manipuri language so as to make the detainees understand easily.

On checking the said vehicle Maruti Swift Dzire bearing regd. No. AS 01AR 9522 white in colour in presence of the two independent civil witnesses, one Carton box was found in the back seat. On opening the cartoon box, I found 60 nos. of Soap caps (i.e. green-10nos., red-24nos., blue-26nos. of soap caps found containing suspected to be Heroin powder inside transparent plastic packets. In presence of the witnesses, on opening the 60 soap caps and on weighing, each packet weighed 12 grams (total 12 x 60 = 720 grams) including the weight of the

suspected to be heroin powder in a big transparent polythene packet and marked as 'A' for identification. Then, from 'A', I extracted 10 grams of heroin powder which was again divided into two equal parts and put inside in two separate transparent plastic packets i.e. 5 grams heroin powder each and inserted inside in two separate yellow paper envelopes which was properly packed and sealed with wax and marked as 'A1' and 'A2' as original and duplicate samples of exhibit respectively. The remaining 710 grams heroin powder after extracting the samples were put inside in a carton box which was properly wrapped with white cloth and sealed with wax and marked as 'A' as parent exhibit. The 60 empty soap caps (i.e. green-10nos., red-24nos., blue-26nos. of soap caps) and 60 empty transparent plastic packet were put inside in a carton box wrapped with transparent cello tape which was marked as 'B' as exhibit.

Then, in presence of the witnesses, I seized the detected (i) 720 grams of heroin powder (ii) one mobile handset (OPPO) along with one Airtel SIM cards bearing mobile No. 8416040272 (iii) One Maruti Dzire bearing Regd. No. AS 01AR 9522 from the possession of Letgin Chongloi (43) yrs s/o Paojahao Chongloi of Khomunnom Village, near Saikul A/P Motbung Luikhoi Veng, PS: Kangpokpi, Dist-KPI, Manipur by preparing a formal weighing and seizure memo at 4:25 pm. Accordingly, he was arrested at 4:50 pm.

On spot interrogation of Letgin Chongloi, he admitted that other three persons in Maruti Swift Dzire bearing regd. no NL 07C 7938 were his accomplice in the said drug business and were going to share the profits obtained by selling the seized heroin powder.

Therefore, in presence of the witnesses, I have seized (i) one mobile handset (Vivo) along with one Airtel SIM cards bearing mobile No. 9612034846 and (ii) one Maruti Dzire bearing regd. No. NL 07C 7938) from the possession of K. Nipuni(29)yrs s/o Kaisii of Taphou Village, Senapati, P.S.- Senapati, Senapati-Dist, Manipur, (i) one mobile handset (MI) along with one SIM card bearing No. 9612509234 from the possession of Kajung Shakpa(30)yrs s/o Shakpa of Maram Khullen, Maram Makha Sagoi, PS: Mao, Senapati-Dist, Manipur and (i) one mobile handset (Motorola) along with one SIM card bearing No. 8732077666 from the possession of Mr. Damlian Osana(35) s/o Daiho Osana of Emesiiphro Village, PO & PS: Senapati, Dist-Senapati, Manipur by preparing a seizure memos at 4.30 pm, 4:35 pm and 4:40 pm respectively. Accordingly, they were arrested at 4.55 pm, 5:00pm and 5:05 pm respectively of the same day by furnishing arrest memos. Then, I obtained the signatures of the accused persons and the witnesses on the weighing and seizure memo, seizure memos, arrest memos and the exhibits in which I also put my signatures on the same.

Thereafter, the arrested accused persons and the seized articles were brought at NAB-PS and handed over the same to OC/NAB-PS along with a written report for taking necessary legal action against the arrested accused person.
