Today i.e. 29/12/2019 at about 12:15 pm while I was at Lilong PS received reliable information that one drug peddler namely Mrs. Fulwar @ Thabi (34) W/o Md. Abdul Samad of Lilong Dam Makhong is selling illegal drug i.e. Heroin No.4 (opium derivative) at her house and some quantities of the said drug is still kept concealed at her house. Accordingly, I recorded the information in writing and a copy of the same was furnished to my senior officer for information. Immediately, two teams of Lilong PS led by me and W/ASI N. Hemolata Devi rushed to the said place without obtaining search authorization as there was great chance of escaping the offender and concealing the drug. I also called upon some volunteers of ANJUMAN at the place so as to witness the scene. On reaching at the house at about 12:40 pm, one lady came out of the house and tried to flee away. Our team managed to detain her and on verification, she disclosed herself as **Mrs. Fulwar @ Thabi (34) W/o Md. Abdul Samad of Lilong Dam Makhong** (owner of the house). Then, I informed her that we have reason to believe that she had sold Heroin No.4 and some quantities of drug is still kept concealed at her house and we would like to conduct house search as well as body search. I informed her verbally as well as in writing about her legal right to be search her body before a Magistrate or Gazetted Officer. In that, she told us not to take her before a Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer to conduct her body search. Subsequently, she took out one black colour polythene carry bag from her wrapped up shawl and dropped the same on the ground disclosing that the black colour polythene carry bag contains 5 grams of Heroin No.4 and she was trying to conceal it. I requested two volunteers of ANJUMAN to be witnessed while opening the black colour polythene carry bag. On opening the black colour polythene carry bag, found yellowish powder substances suspected to be Heroin No. 4. On weighing the powder substance, it weight 5.3 grams excluding the weight of the container. Out of 5.3 grams of suspected Heroin No. 4, extracted 2 grams suspected Heroin No. 4, put one gram each inside two small transparent polythene and packed. The packed two small transparent polythene containing one gram of each suspected Heroin No. 4 was again inserted inside two yellow envelopes and marked as A1 & A2 as original & duplicate sample respectively. The remaining 3.3 grams of suspected Heroin No. 4 was put inside small transparent polythene and packed. The packed small transparent polythene containing 3.3 grams of suspected Heroin No. 4 was put inside the original black colour polythene carry bag, inserted it inside a yellow envelop and marked as A as parent sample. The exhibits marked as A, A1 & A2 were packed and sealed in presence of witnesses. Hence, she was arrested at 1.30 pm of the day and seized the detected drugs from her possession at 1:35 pm of the day and brought at Lilong PS.

Hence, a regular case under **FIR No. 132(12)2019 LIL-PS U/s 21(b) ND&PS Act** has been registered for investigation.
