

Today i.e. 16/01/2020 at 5:15 pm while I was at Lilong Police Station received a reliable information that one suspected drug peddler namely Md. Thembung (30) S/o Md. Rousan Ali of Lilong Mairenkhun Makha, under the protection of his brothers, is selling illegal drugs i.e. illegal cough syrups, at his house and some quantities of the said drugs are still kept concealed at his house. Accordingly, I recorded the information in writing and a copy of the same was furnished to my senior officer for information. Immediately, I along with my Police Party rushed to the said place without obtaining search authorization as there was a great chance of escaping of the suspected offender and concealing the drug. I also called upon some volunteers of All Lilong Anti Drug Association (ALADA) to witness the search/raid. At about 05:30 pm of the day, I along with my Police team reached at the said house and cordoned the house from different directions. In presence of volunteers of ALADA while we started house search of first room of the house, heard firing sounds/gun shots of gun probably barrel gun just outside the house. On hearing the firing sounds, immediately Police team ran outside of the house and looked for it. I saw one unknown person later identified as Mv. Sahidur @ Thambou (38) S/o Md. Rousan Ali of Lilong Mairenkhun Makha was firing barrel gun pointing towards our team. By doing it, he (Mv. Sahidur @ Thambou) ran away from there. By the time, one another unknown person later identified as Md. Abdul Majid (33) S/o Md. Rousan Ali of Lilong Mairenkhun Makha fired barrel gun upon our team and in that, one unknown person sustained bullet injuries on his person and one of our police personnel C/No. 0908187 Longjam Bokul Singh of Lilong PS also got pellet injuries on his person. We took positions to save ourselves from the firing and in the mean time, public started yelling "Mee Haatle" "Mee Haatle". Immediately our Police team tried to overpower one of the firer (Md. Abdul Majid) but public already gathered there got violent and started pelting stones towards us. In that also, one of our police personnel namely C/No. 0908525 Md. Farooque of Lilong PS got injury on his person. By taking advantages of darkness and situation, the firer (Md. Abdul Majid) fled away from the spot leaving behind the **DBBL gun** used by him. Our police team came out to a nearby safer place with the **DBBL gun** left behind by the firer (Md. Abdul Majid) and informed senior officers about the incident. In the mean time, it was learnt that the unknown person who sustained bullet injuries succumbed to his injuries. Later on the deceased was identified as Md. Shajid Khan (35) S/o Md. Azad Khan of Lilong Mairenkhun Makha.

Hence, a suo motto case under **FIR No. 09(1)2020 LIL-PS U/s- 302/307/326/189/34 IPC & 25(I-C) Arms Act** has been registered for investigation.
