Subject:- **Report.**

Sir,


With due respect, I have the honour to report that, as per order No.4/21(4)/2018-NAB/Dest/182 dated 1st February 2020 of SP/NAB, Manipur, my team along with the combined teams of District Police Imphal East, District Police Imphal West, Armed personnel of 15th AR Bn., Armed personnel of 6th IRB, Special CDO team, officials of District Magistrate Kangpokpi and Home guard were detailed to carry out destruction of illicit Opium poppy cultivation in S. Phailengkot hill range, PS-Sagolmang, Kangpokpi District, Manipur on 4th February 2020. Accordingly on the same day i.e. 04/02/2020 at @ 7.00 am, our combined team proceeded towards the said area. On reaching at the hill side of S. Phailengkot hill range at @ 08:00 a.m. of the day, we have seen the IVR road leading to S. Phailengkot hill range was already obstructed by some unknown persons (suspected to be the poppy cultivators). However, we have cleared the said obstructed area and rushed towards the said hill side and reached the S. Phailengkot hill range at @ 8.30 am. After furnishing the attachment and destruction order of the illicit opium poppy cultivation in the said area u/s 48 of ND&PS Act, 1985, as amended by the officer of District Magistrate Kangpokpi, the area of the land was also measured by him and found to be 135 acres. No one came forward to claim the ownership of the cultivation. Then, we examined the plants systematically and confirmed that the same was opium/poppy plants. One of the poppy pod was cut with a sharp blade which produces white milky fluid. On closure examination, it was found that in a 1/1 metre area there were about 20 plants. Hence, I drew 02 (two) respective samples (two poppy pods) which were put inside two separated plastic packets and further inserted inside two separate yellow paper envelopes which was properly packed and sealed by Wax and marked as A¹ and A² as original and duplicate samples respectively. As unavailability of any independent witnesses at the spot, I requested two officers of my team in order to stand as witnesses. Then, in presence of the witnesses, I seized the said two poppy pod at 3:00 p.m. of the day (04/02/2020). Then, the witnesses put their signatures on the samples. Then, the illicit opium/poppy plants were cut down/uprooted and burnt as per provision of law. It was expected to yield 1350 kgs. @ (10kgs./acre) of opium. Details of the photography were taken for adducing evidence if required in the court of law.


It is therefore reporting to you along with a written report and handed over the seized poppy pods along with its relevant documents kindly to take up further necessary legal action as per provision of law.
