Subject: Report

Sir,

With due respect, I have the honour to report that today i.e. 19/12/2020 at about 6:00 a.m, receiving a reliable information that one Maruti van bearing regd No MNO4A/8681 (White in colour) along with some quantities of Heroin powder were detained by the villagers of Lower Takou, PS- Tamei Dist- Tamenglong at their village. However, the villagers could not detained the culprits as they were already escaped from the spot after taking the advantages of darkness. Accordingly, on the same day at around 7:00a.m., I along with SI S. Premananda Singh and police team of NAB-PS under the supervision of OC-NAB/PS rushed towards the spot along with field testing kit and weighing scale. On reaching the spot i.e. Lower Takou Village, PS- Tamei Dist- Tamenglong at around 12:30p.m., I met the Village Chairman as well as the President of the said village. Thereafter, they identified the said involved Maruti van bearing regd No MNO4A/8681 (White in colour) which was parked beside the youth club of the Lower Takou Village. Then in presence of them, I along with my teams started checking the said vehicle, in that all doors were opened and the key was found in its keyhole. On further checking, one polythene bag black in colour was found lying under the front seat.

Further, I requested two passer-by persons (villagers) and requested them to be witnesses in conducting some legal procedures where they voluntarily agreed to stand as witnesses. In presence of them, I opened the said black plastic polythene and found some packets of suspected to be Heroin powder and on counting, it was found to be 22 nos. of small transparent plastic packets of suspected Heroin powder and on weighing one packet of suspected to be Heroin powder, it was found to be 12grams and grand total is 264grams of suspected Heroin powder (i.e. 12grams x 22 = 264grams) Then, I took out a pinch of suspected to be Heroin powder from each packet and tested with the help of Field testing kit brought by us and on testing, it gave positive result of Heroin Powder. As all the packets were identical in shape, size, weight and colour, I put all the reddish colour powder suspected to be heroin powder in a big transparent polythene packet. Then, from the same packet, I extracted 10 grams of heroin powder which was again divided into two equal parts and put inside in two separate transparent plastic packets i.e. 5 grams heroin powder each and inserted inside in two separate brown paper envelopes which was properly packed and sealed with wax and marked as 'A1' and 'A2' as original and duplicate samples of exhibit respectively. The remaining 254 grams of heroin powder after extracting the samples and the empty 22 plastic packets and the container i.e. black polythene were put inside in a big yellow colour paper envelop which was properly packed and sealed with wax and marked as 'A' as parent exhibit.

Again, on opening of the tool box of the said Maruti Van, I found some documents (Zerox copies of Aadhar Card in the name of (i) Hafijuddin S/o. Md. Saheruddin of Urup Khunou Maning Konyathabi Arapti, I/E, (ii) Md. Yahiya Khan C/o. Md. Rashid Ali of Tera Khongsangbi Mamang Leikai, Moirang, (iii) Md. Sahid Khan S/o. Md. Abdul Samad of Kyamgei Muslim Makha Leikai, (iv) Md. Bm Zamir S/o. Md. Zalin of Lilong Turel Ahanbi and (v) one Zerox copy of Driving Licence in r/o Md. Sahid Khan S/o. Md. Abdul Samad of Kyamgei Makha Leikai as well as one Smart Card of the said Maruti Van in the name of one Najir Hussain S/o. Haji Rajab Ali of Lilong Haoreibi Turel Ahanbi were found.




Then, in presence of the witnesses, I seized the detected (i) 254 grams of heroin powder marked as "A"(ii) exhibit marked as "A1" and "A2" containing 5 grams each of Heroin powder and (iii) one Maruti van bearing regd No MNO4A/8681 (White in colour), (iv) one Smart Card in the name of one Najir Hussain, (v) Four zerox copies of Aadhar Cards in r/o Halijuddin, Md. Yahiya Khan, Md. Sahid Khan and Md. Bm Zamir, (vi) one Zerox copy of Driving Licence in r/o Md. Sahid Khan by preparing a formal weighing and seizure memo at 2:00 pm of the same day. Then, I obtained the signatures of the witnesses on the weighing and seizure memo, and the exhibits in which I also put my signatures on the same.

Thereafter, I brought the said seized articles at NAB-PS and handed over the same to OC/NAB-PS along with a written report for taking necessary legal action.
