Subject: Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that, today i.e. 26th February, 2020 at @ 09:30 p.m. while I was at NAB PS; one of my source men came to me and informed that one TATA truck bearing regd. No. AS01 JC 1314 having a huge consignment of cough syrup containing codeine phosphate is parked at Lukram Leirak, Imphal West. Accordingly, I recorded the statement of the source man in written and a copy of the same was furnished to SP/NAB, Manipur for kind information and further necessary action. Immediately, I along with the source man and a team of NAB PS with necessary equipments rushed towards Lukram Leirak for looking the same TATA truck bearing regd. No. AS01 JC 1314 without obtaining search order/warrant as there was great chance of escape of the culprit and concealment of the huge consignment of cough syrup containing codeine phosphate. At about 10.00 p.m. of the day, I saw the same TATA truck bearing regd. No. AS01 JC 1314 parked near Ima Yaipha Shanglen, Lukram Leirak. Immediately, I along with my team went near the said TATA truck and found two persons near TATA truck. Then, I detained them for verification and checking the TATA truck. Then, I called upon two civil witnesses available at the said spot to stand as witnesses while I conduct some legal formalities. On spot verification, one identified himself as Moirangthem Rabi Singh 33 yrs s/o M. Loken Singh of Khongjom Laibung Leikai, PO/PS-TBL (driver of the Vehicle) and another identified himself as Heisnam Inaoba Singh (27) S/o H.Laxman of Hiyangkhang, Laphupat Tera, IW, Manipur A/p Sangaiporou near Bordin workshop in presence of the witnesses.

I informed the detainees as per section 50 of ND&PS Act, verbally as well as in written about his legal right of searching his personal search as well as his belongings in presence of a magistrate or a gazetted officer since they are suspected to have possessed a huge consignment of cough syrup containing codeine phosphate in the TATA truck. On that, the detainees opted to search his belongings and the vehicle in presence of civil independent witnesses. Option statement of the detainees was also recorded by me in written and the same was also read out and translate into Manipuri language so as to make the detainee understand easily.

On conducting the search of the said vehicle in presence of the witnesses, I found 70 similar carton boxes in the back side body of the truck. I marked all the 70 carton boxes as 1,2,3,4.....to 70 for identification. On opening of all the 70 carton boxes in presence of the witnesses, each carton box was found contained 100 bottles of Bolirex Cough Syrup containing 10 mg Codeine Phosphate which was levelled in their composition (in total 70 carton boxes x 100 bottles = 7000). As all the bottles i.e 7000 bottles of Bolirex Cough Syrup containing 10 mg Codeine Phosphate containing inside the 70 carton boxes are similar and having same batch No. TBHS1737. So, I took out all the 7000 bottles of Bolirex Cough Syrup containing 10 mg Codeine Phosphate from its original containers (70 carton boxes) which was kept together and took out 2(two) bottles of Bolirex Cough Syrup containing 10 mg Codeine Phosphate and put inside in two separate yellow paper envelopes each which were properly packed, sealed and marked as "A1" and "A2" as original and duplicate samples respectively in presence of the witnesses. The remaining 6998 Bolirex Cough Syrup containing 10 mg Codeine Phosphate after extracting the samples were put inside a 23 (twenty three) gunny bags and markets as A,B,C.....W, i.e A-298 bottles, B-300 bottles, C-300 bottles, D-

300 bottles, E-300 bottles, F-300 bottles, G-300 bottles, H-300 bottles, I-300 bottles, J-300 bottles, K-300 bottles, L-400 bottles, M-300 bottles, N-300 bottles, O-300 bottles, P-300 bottles, Q-300 bottles, R-300 bottles, S-300 bottles, T-300 bottles, U-300 bottles, V-300 bottles and W-300 bottles as parent exhibits. And all the empty carton boxes were also put inside 12 gunny bags and marked as 1,2,3.....12.

On preliminary interrogation the detainee Moirangthem Rabi Singh (33) s/o M. Loken Singh of Khongjom Laibung Leikai, PO/PS-TBL disclosed that he brought the consignment from Guwahati to deliver at Imphal.

In presence of the witnesses, I seized the detected (i) 6998 Bolirex Cough Syrup containing 10 mg Codeine Phosphate along with the empty carton boxes (ii) one brownish leather money bag (iii) one Election Voter I-Card r/o Moirangthem Rabi Singh (iv) one AADHAAR card No. 3901 1501 9302 in r/o Moirangthem Rabi Singh (v) one Axis Bank ATM card (vi) Rs.232 (100x2+10x1+5x2+2x5+1x2 INR) (vii) one SAMSUNG mobile handset(keypad) without SIM card (viii) one MI mobile handset having mobile no. (a) 8837334587 (Jio) and (b) 8974099388 (Airtel) (ix) one TATA truck bearing Registration No. AS 01JC 1314, (x) one Driving Licence in r/o Moirangthem Rabi Singh were seized from the possession of Moirangthem Rabi Singh (33) s/o M. Loken Singh of Khongjom Laibung Leikai, PO/PS-TBL at 1:05 a.m of 27/02/2020 by preparing a formal weighing and seizure memo.

Further, (i) one MI mobile handset along with Mobile Nos. 6009171748 (Jio) (ii) Rs.80 (50x1+10x3 INR) were seized from the possession of Heisnam Inaoba Singh (27) S/o H.Laxman of Hiyangkhong, Laphupat Tera, IW, Manipur A/p Sangaiporou near Bordin workshop at 1:10 a.m of 27/02/2020 by preparing a formal seizure memo and they were arrested on the spot at 1.15 am & 1.20 am of 27/02/2020 respectively by preparing arrest memos. Then, I obtained the signatures of the accused persons and the witnesses on the weighing and seizure memo, seizure memo, arrest memo and the exhibits in which I also put my signatures on the same.

Thereafter, the 2 (two) arrested persons along with all seized articles and its relevant documents are handed over the same along with a written report to OC/NAB PS for taking necessary legal action as per provision of law.
