Zalauluddin of Lilong Atoukhong Laiphrakpam joined/attended the recently held Tablighi Jamaat Congregation at Nizamuddin, Delhi. They returned at Imphal, Manipur on 11/03/2020, 11/03/2020 and 18/03/2020 respectively. Despite Government of Manipur Gazetted Notification No.31/08/2020-M dated 13th March, 2020 read with order by the Chief Secretary, Government of Manipur No. 9/6(1)/2020-H(Pt) dated 24/03/2020 and repeated appeals through the social media and local print and electronic media to voluntarily come out to those who visited COVID-19 hotspot countries/states to the medical authorities, the above mentioned 3(three) persons did not come out. Their negligent acts are known to be likely to spread infection of COVID-19, malignantly doing known to be likely to spread infection disease and knowingly disobeying quarantine rule.

You are, therefore, requested to take necessary legal action accordingly.
