Today i.e. 29/10/2020 since the early morning, in compliance with SP/TBL signal No. S/11/2020/SP/TBL/468 dated 27/10/2020, I along with police party were discharging duties at Lilong Ushoipokpi Bazar in c/w the 48 Hrs state wide General Strike (from the midnight of 28/10/2020 to midnight of 30/10/2020) called by All Manipur Muslim Students Organization (AMMSO) & Pangal Students, Union Dhana Manjuri University (PSUDMU) allege and protesting for non reservation of 4% quota for OBC (MP) students in non-professional courses for the academic session 2020-2021. In the meanwhile, at about 11:05 received an information that a large number of individuals numbering about 150/200 who are said to be the Bandh supporters came out at Lilong Bazar area and disturbed to the passerby, commuters and plying vehicles by shouting different slogans relating to non-reservation of 4% quota for OBC (MP) students in non-professional courses. I along with Police Party immediately rushed at Lilong Bazar and tried to convince the protestors. Ultimately, the protestors blocked NH-102 and organized an unlawful assembly. Police interrupted the unlawful assembly and tried to disperse it. The protestors became unruly mob and resorted to pelting stones towards the Security Personnel, commuters and plying vehicles. The mob became more violent and continued pelting stone. The situation was informed to superior officers and they also came to the spot. Since there are no other alternative options, with the order of E/M detailed/concerned, Police used mild Lathi Charge and tear gas smoke shells in order to disperse the unruly mob. Finally, the mob was dispersed at around 1:00 pm of the day. During the mob, it is reported that 2/3 civil vehicles (particulars unknown) were reportedly damaged.

Hence a suo motto case under **FIR No. 92(10)2020LIL-PS U/s 143/147/149/151/152/188/427 IPC, 7 Cril. Law Amendment Act, 1932** has been registered for investigation.
