Subject:- Report

Sir,

I have the honour to report that today i.e. 07/03/2021 at about 8.00 pm while I received a reliable information from my source that there is brown sugar factory at the residences of Md. Maneruddin (49) S/O (L) Md. Najeruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai and Md. Manergul (53) S/O (L) Md. Najeruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai (premises). Accordingly, the information was taken down in writing and a copy of the same was forwarded to Sachidananda Soibam, MPS, Addl SP(Ops)/TBL for kind information. I also informed the Addl. SP (Ops), Thoubal telephonically. I obtained the search authorization from Additional Superintendent of Police (Ops), Thoubal and an Executive Magistrate was also informed. Since, there is high chance of completion of the manufacturing process and shifting of the processing unit as well as the processed materials, without further delay a combined team of Thoubal District Police including H. Johnny Sharma, SDPO-TBL, Inpst. N. Suresh Singh, RI-TBL, Inspt. Md. Riaj Khan, OC Lilong PS, S.I. S. Ibomcha Singh of Thoubal PS and others CDO-TBL teams and woman police led by Sachidananda Soibam, MPS, Addl SP(OPS)/TBL, under the supervision of Dr. S. Ibomcha Singh, MPS, Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District rushed to the residence of Md. Maneruddin (49) S/O (L) Md. Najeruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai and Md. Manergul (53) S/O (L) Md. Najeruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai. The search had to take place at night because of the reasons mentioned above. Our police party cordoned the said two residences and found two men inside the house of Md. Maneruddin and one person inside the house of Md. Manergul and they were detained for verification and identification and there was some sharp foul smell coming out of the houses. On verification, they identified themselves as (1) Md. Yunush Khan (22) S/O Md. Maneruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai (2) Bogimayum Sher Shaha (23) S/O B. Asraf Ali of Uchiwa Wangbal Makha Leikai and (3) Md. Manergul (53) S/O (L) Md. Najeruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai.

The police found the brown sugar manufacturing factory in the courtyard of the houses of Md. Maneruddin. The following items were detected from the courtyard of the first house of Md. Maneruddin and also detected the following drugs and articles which are suspected to have been used in manufacturing the contraband Heroin (brown sugar) at the court yard /premises of accused Md. Maneruddin (49) S/O (L) Md. Najeruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai :-

Afterwards, I offered the two accused namely Md. Yunus Khan and Bogimayum Sher Shaha whether they would want their body to be searched in the presence of Gazetted officer or Executive Magistrate. In that, they offered to search their body in presence of a Gazetted officer. Accordingly, I informed Shri H. Johny Sharma, MPS, SDPO-TBL to be witness during body search of the above individuals.

Upon searching of the body of Md. Yunus Khan, the following items were found:-

1. Samung Duos Mobile Phone black in colour.
2. One Redmi MI Pro Mobile phone light blue in colour.

Upon searching of the body of Bogimayum Sher Shaha, the following items were found:-

1. One Redmi MI Note 9 Mobile phone gold colour and seized

Further on searching the house of accused Md. Manergul in presence of Shri H. Johnny Sharma, MPS, SDPO-TBL as Gazetted Police Officer and Zamilur Rahaman as Executive Magistrate witnesses including woman police, the police team also detected the following drugs and articles which are suspected to have been used in manufacturing the contraband Heroin(brown sugar) at the court yard/premises of accused Md. Manergul :-

(1) Heroin (brown sugar)- 2 cement bags weighing (a) 22.590 Kg and (b) 30.770 Kg including the weight of container and marked as 53 and 54 for identification. (2) Cash – Rs. 15,500/ which is the sale proceed of illegal drugs.

Afterwards, I offered the accused namely Md. Manergul whether he would want his body to be searched in the presence of Gazetted officer or Executive Magistrate. In that, he offered to search his body in presence of a Gazetted officer. Accordingly, I informed Shri H. Johnny Sharma, MPS, SDPO-TBL to be witness during body search of the above individual. Upon searching of the body of Md. Manergul, no incriminating item was found.

On examination of accused Yunush Khan, he disclosed that the drug factory was run by (1) Md. Maneruddin (49) S/O (L) Md. Najeruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai (2) Md. Anish Khan (19) S/O Md. Maneruddin of –do- (3) Md. Mustofa (19) S/O Md. Manerugul of –do- (4) Md. Akbar Khan (51) S/O Md. Chaoba of Thoubal Moijing Wangmataba (5) Bogimayum Sher Shaha (23) S/O B. Asraf Ali of Uchiwa Wangbal Makha Leikai (6) Md. Manergul (53) S/O (L) Md. Najeruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai.

Finally all the exhibits were seized by preparing a formal weighing and seizure memo at 11.00 pm and 11.20 pm from the possession of Md. Yunush Khan (22) S/O Md. Maneruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai and Md. Manergul (53) S/O (L) Md. Najeruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai respectively and arrested the three accused persons namely (1) Md. Yunush Khan (22) S/O Md. Maneruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai (2) Bogimayum Sher Shaha (23) S/O B. Asraf Ali of Uchiwa Wangbal Makha Leikai and (3) Md. Manergul (53) S/O (L) Md. Najeruddin of Lilong Nungei Khunou Mamang Leikai by preparing formal arrest memo at 11.30 pm, 11.35 pm and 11.40 pm respectively from the spots.

The arrested person along with seized items were handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action against them.
