Subject: Complaint for taking up appropriate actions against the persons named Md. Shahil, from Assam and Md. Saddam from Lilong, for beating the husband of the undersigned on the night of 11/04/2021 and subsequently had succumbed to his injury accompanied by snatching of vehicle Tata 207 DI EX bearing Registration No. MN06LA2836, Chasis No. MAT374445HSG07873, Engine No. 4SPCR10GSYS623473 owned by my husband.

Sir,

I, have the honour to state the following few facts and circumstances for your perusal and necessary favourable actions:-

That, I am the bereaved wife of (L) Swapan Ghosh who expired on 06/05/2021 after a prolonged treatment at Shija Hospital, Imphal and discharged on 06/05/2021 from the same Hospital later diagnosed as Sars Covid 19 patient. That my aforesaid husband is survived by the undersigned two minor children of 12 years and 8 years old respectively.

That, my husband was a small scale businessman dealing with various daily necessities. That due to the advent of pandemic in all over the world, we have been finding it very difficult to survive and as such my husband who used to run up and down to Guwahati Imphal could not find business due to the frequent lockdown imposed to curtail the disease. That one Md. Sahil from Guwahati used to be associated with my husband and he had also visited to the rent house where the family of the deceased has been living. That my husband has still left to clear some due amount to Md. Sahil, (approximately about Rs. 2 Lacs). That the undersigned also is aware that my then husband used to transact money with Md. Sahil in the Axis Bank Account No. 916010069330161 in the name of Md. Saddam, a resident of Lilong. That my husband due to financial crunch faced due to failure in his business due to the pandemic situation have stopped the payments to be made to Md. Sahil and this situation was also made known to him.

That on the fateful day of 11/04/2021, my husband had left for going to Churachandpur by driving the Tata DI vehicle mentioned in the above subject. On his way back he had ranged to the undersigned that Md. Sahil and Md. Saddam had told him to meet him at Lilong and for that he needed to go there at Lilong before coming home. At about 9 p.m the undersigned received a call from the mobile no. of her husband and Md. Sahil was on the line instated of her husband. Md. Sahil told the undersigned to bring the car and rescue her husband. However the car being sold off long back was told to Md. Sahil by the undersigned, then the phone was put on switched off mode. As the husband of the undersigned did not returned home the

undersigned along with the help of his younger brother went to search for him at Lilong, but as they do not know where is the place they couldn't get any clue and had to come back. At about 2 am the phone came from the husband stating that they have left him in front of the High Court complex at Koirengai and from there he was brought home. When inquired he did not speak much but that the vehicle was taken away by the groups of Md. Sahil and Md. Saddam, beyond that he did not speak. He looked tired and reddened but was with no injury marks and thus went to sleep. The next morning he complained of having severe headache and took medicine on his own to sustain the pain. However the headache was becoming unbearable even inspite of taking SOS medicine and as such went to Babina Diagnostic for a CT scan. He was hospitalised at RIMS on 25/04/2021 and placed at the causality, he was found to have been Covid -ve. On 27/04/2021 he was taken to Shija Hospital, there he was found to a Covid +ve. On 6/5/2021 as the undersigned could not bear the hospital Bills got him discharged against the Medical advice, however de died on the same while reaching home.

The undersigned could not reveal the fact of the matter as it was against the will of her husband (now deceased). While he was alive he told the undersigned that he was beaten badly on his head by the party of Md. Sahil and Md. Saddam on 12/04/2021. They had threatened him by way of showing arms not to narrate the story to anyone and as such he had instructed the undersigned not to reveal the fact.

That now the undersigned has become a widow, along with two minor children, the Tata DI registered in the name of her husband has been illegally snatched away by the team of Md.Sahil and Md.Saddam.

The undersigned hereby request to kindly cause the arrest of the two persons to find out the truth of the matter and also for recovery of the vehicle being Tata 207 DI EX bearing Registration no. MN06LA2836, Chasis No. MAT374445HSG07873, Engine No. 4SPCR10GSYS623473 from the custody of the criminals.

The delay in lodging the FIR is due to the pandemic situation as the undersigned along with her family were put to isolation and under containment zone and as such the delay may be treated as bonafide.

For this act of kindness the humble applicant as on duty bound shall ever pray.
