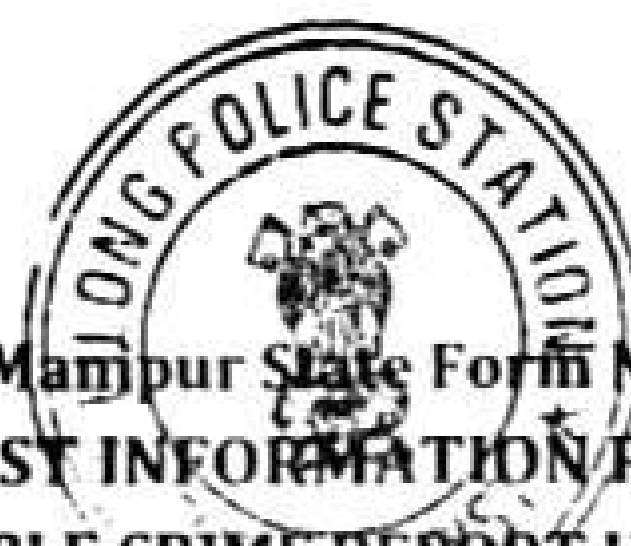

Subject: Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that on 10/07/2021 at about 08:30 pm, received an information from my own source man that one person namely Makakmayum Nasir Khan @ Amu, S/o. Makakmayum Rashid Ahamad of Lilong Haoreibi Turel Ahanbi Darul Uloom Mathak was selling illegal drugs to drugs abuser at his house. After verifying the veracity of the source report, I recorded the information statement of the source man in writing and a copy of the same report was submitted to Officer in Charge Lilong Police Station for information and necessary action. Accordingly, I obtained the search authorization warrant from SP/TBL. Immediately, a police team of Lilong Police Station led by OC-LIL PS including woman police and CDO/TBL Havildar Md. Kamal Hassan under the supervision of Superintendent of Police, Thoubal including the source man with necessary equipment rushed at the residence of Makakmayum Nasir Khan @ Amu (34) yrs, S/o. Makakmayum Rashid Ahamad of Lilong Haoreibi Turel Ahanbi Darul Uloom Mathak. On reaching the spot, the source man indicates the house of drug seller. So our police party cordoned the said house and the family members/all the rooms of the house were kept under surveillance. In that one person was found inside the house and he was detained for verification. I identified myself as police officer of Lilong PS and my team also police personnel of Lilong PS and CDO/TBL. Then, I asked the identity of the detainee in presence of witnesses. On that he identified himself as Makakmayum Nasir Khan @ Amu (34) yrs, S/o. Makakmayum Rashid Ahamad of Lilong Haoreibi Turel Ahanbi Darul Uloom Mathak. Then, I showed the search authorization warrant to the detainee Makakmayum Nasir Khan @ Amu and some volunteer member of All Manipur Muslim Development Committee and Manipur Muslim Welfare Organization were informed to be witnesses during the searched of the above detainee. Afterwards, I offered him whether he would want his body and belongings to be searched in the presence of Gazetted officer or Executive Magistrate. Then, he offered to search his body in presence of Gazetted officer as witnesses. Accordingly, I informed Shri H. Johnny Sharma, MPS, SDPO-TBL to be witness during searching the body and belonging of the above individual. On searching the body no incriminating articles was found. On searching the belonging of the detainee in presence of Shri H. Johnny Sharma, MPS, SDPO-TBL as Gazetted Police Officer witness and independent witness, the police team found one black polythene and one small cartoon box from his room. On opening the black polythene, found 17 nos. of filled plastic bottle containing of suspected Heroin No. 4 weighing the following weight (i) 1.1 gram (ii) 3.2 gram (iii) 1.0 gram (iv) 1.2 gram (v) 1.0 gram (vi) 1.2 gram (vii) 1.3 gram (viii) 1.0 gram (ix) 1.3 gram (x) 1.0 gram (xi) 1.1 gram (xii) 0.9 gram (xiii) 1.1 gram (xiv) 1.2 gram (xv) 0.8 gram (xvi) 1.0 gram (xvii) 1.2 gram respectively including the weight of plastic bottle container. And on opening the small cartoon box found (i) 175 (one hundred

seventy five) nos. of "SEMPLEX+" commonly known as SP capsules, (ii) 137 (one hundred thirty seven) nos. WY tablets(Methamphetamine), (iii) 14 (fourteen) nos. of N-10 tablets (Nitrosun) and (iv) One bottle containing of suspected Heroin No.4 weighing 27.2 grams including the weight of bottle.

Finally all the exhibits were seized by preparing a formal weighing and seizure memo on 10/07/2021 at 10:30 pm from the possession of Makakmayum Nasir Khan @ Amu (34) yrs, S/o. Makakmayum Rashid Ahamad of Lilong Haoreibi Turel Ahanbi Darul Uloom Mathak and also arrested him on 10/07/2021 at 10:40 pm by preparing a formal arrest memo.

So, the arrested person along with the seized articles are handed over to you for further necessary action.


