Subject:- Report

Sir,

I have the honour to report that today i.e. 29/08/2021 at about 5.45 pm one of my source man gave an information that one unknown person will be transporting illegal drugs items from Thoubal side towards Lilong Bazar in one Baleno car bearing registration No. MN01AG-1266. Accordingly, after verifying the veracity of source report, the information was taken down in writing and a copy of the same was forwarded to Officer in Charge, Lilong Police Station for kind information and further necessary action. Accordingly, I obtained the search authorization from Superintendent of Police, Thoubal. Immediately, two team of Lilong PS led by Inspt. Md. Riaj Khan, OC LIL-PS conducted frisking and checking of suspected vehicles at two strategic point, one team at Lilong Alia Lamkhai and one team at in front of Lilong PS gate along with source man volunteer member of ALADA with necessary equipments under the supervision of Superintendent of Police, Thoubal. While conducting frisking and checking, one Baleno car dark grey in colour bearing registration No.MN01AG-1266 was seen proceeding from Thoubal side towards Lilong side along NH - 102 hiding behind one Tata truck in a suspicious manner. On seeing the police team, the unknown driver of the Baleno car bearing No. MN01AG-1266 was trying to U-turn the vehicle. Immediately, the police team rushed and overpowered in front of Noor Hospital and Research Institute, Lilong khunou along NH-102 and detained for verification. I identified myself as police officer and my team also police personnel of Lilong PS team. Then, I asked the identity of the detainee in presence of the witnesses. In that he identified himself as Yumkhaibam Sahabuddin @ Abo (50) S/O (L) Md. Samsur Jaman of Kwakta Bazar A/P Lilong Bazar. Afterwards, I offered him whether he would want his body to be searched in the presence of Gazetted officer or Executive Magistrate. In that, he opted to search his body in presence of a Gazetted officer as witnesses. Accordingly, I informed Shri Johny Sharma, MPS, SDPO/TBL to be witness during searching the body of the above individual. On searching the body of the individual in presence of Shri Johny Sharma, MPS, SDPO/TBL as Gazetted Police Officer witness, the police team found two transparent polythene packets of suspected S.P Capsule marked as Spas-Primevon from the possession of accused Yumkhaibam Sahabuddin @ Abo and no incriminating articles was found from inside the vehicle. On counting, one packet contained 693/ (six hundred ninety three) nos and another packet contained 761/(seven hundred sixty one) nos. of suspected S.P. Capsule. So, the suspected S.P. Capsule including the vehicle Baleno bearing No. MNO1AG-1266 was seized by preparing a formal weighing and seizure memo from the possession of accused

Yumkhaibam Sahabuddin @ Abo (50) S/O Samsur Jaman of Kwakta Bazar A/P Lilong Bazar in presence of witnesses on 29/08/2021 at 7.00 pm. On preliminary examination of accused Yumkhaibam Sahabuddin @ Abo, he stated that he had concealed some suspected S.P Capsule inside his shop located at Lilong Bazar for selling to drugs abuser. Accordingly, the police team along with women police including Shri Johny Sharma, MPS SDPO/TBL and accused person Yumkhaibam Sahabuddin @ Abo rushed at the shop. On further searching the shop, the police team detected one small black polythene containing 1400/(one thousand four hundred) nos of suspected S.P. capsule marked as SIMPLEX + from the rack of shop and one black polythene containing 3/(three)nos of suspected Codeine phosphate and Chlorpheniramine of 100 ml capacity and 3/(three) empty bottles of codeine of 100 ml capacity. On counting, contained 1400/(one thousand four hundred) nos of suspected S.P Capsule. So the suspected S.P. Capsule and codeine was seized by preparing formal weighing and seizure memo in presence of witnesses on 29/08/2021 at 7.45 pm and arrested the accused person Yumkhaibam Sahabuddin @ Abo (50) S/O (L) Md. Samsur Jaman of Kwakta Bazar A/P Lilong Bazar by preparing a formal arrest memo in presence of witnesses on 29/08/2020 at 8.00 pm.

The arrested person along with seized items are handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action against him.
