Today i.e., 11/11/2021 at 8:00 am, while conducting land demarcation at Lilong Chingkhram Hills for construction of a police out post by the staff of SDO & SDC Lilong under adequate security measures of police teams comprising District police Thoubal teams, CDO/Imphal East, CDO/Imphal West, CDO/Bisnupur and CDO/Kakching teams including women police, a large number of unknown individuals of different age groups numbering about 400/500 who are said to be the villagers of Lilong Chingkhram Muslim including males and females came out by holding deadly weapons like sticks, iron rod, stones etc. and protest/obstructed the lawful duties of SDO & SDC Lilong and police teams and protest against the land demarcation. The said unknown protesters organized an unlawful assembly/unruly mob. The protesters are directed to disperse the unlawful assembly by the Executive Magistrate within a stipulated timing within 10 minutes. However instead of dispersing the unlawful assembly the mob supporters become more and more violent and attacked the SDO & SDC Lilong and police teams on duty with holding sticks and iron rod as well as pelting stones. During the violent acts of mob members some houses of Lilong Chingkhram Kabui Village were caused partly damages. Accordingly, the police team who were on duty tried to disperse the formidable violent mob with using mild force. But the mob members became more and more violent despite repeated instructions and warning has been given them to disperse themselves the unruly mob. Since there is no alternative option, police teams on duty fired tear gas cells/smokes (anti-riot equipment) under the order of concerned Executive Magistrate on duty and dispersed the unruly mob/unlawful assembly with using minimum force at about 08:30 am of the same day. Thus the unruly mob was gradually calm down and controlled the situation at about 10:05 am of the same day. It is reportedly learnt that some members of the arrogant mob members received minor injuries on their persons while dispersing the unlawful assembly and some police personnel were also received minor injuries on their persons due to hit by the stones pelted by the arrogant mob members.

So, a suo motto case under FIR No. 106(11)2021 LIL-PS U/S 143/144/145/147/188/353/325/427 IPC has been registered for investigation.
