Sir,


I have the honour to report that today i.e. 07/04/2022 at about 15.00hrs, a team of Lilong Police Station including lady constables conducted random frisking and checking by way of foot patrolling in and around the area of Lilong Bazar.

That, while the team was patrolling and checking randomly along the road one woman who was with a black colour bag was checked. In that some dark brown sticky substance was detected suspected to be opium.

That, on being asked and on seeing the confidence nature of the Police team, she identified herself as Tika Acharya (48) yrs W/o Vishnu Acharya of Kalapahar (upper) P.O Kalapahar, PS Kangpokpi, District Kangpokpi and stated that the substance she was carrying is opium (Kani) and further stated that she brought the opium from one unknown person from Ukhrul in order to sell out to some willing buyer for her wrongful gain. Accordingly the substance containing in the black lady bag i.e. (i) one plastic packet blue in colour, printed "Everyday salt" suspected to contain Opium (Kani) weighing about 500gms (ii) one mobile hand set Samsung J-7 bearing IMEI Nos. 353632097849213 & 353633097849211, having mobile number 9366324058 (iii) a sum of Rs. 9300/- (Rupees nine thousand three hundred) only, was seized at 1540hrs from her possession and on her production. It is to mention no one was willing to cooperate to witness the seizure, on being requested.

In the light of the above facts and circumstances, she was arrested at 1553hrs. The arrested accused person along with the seized items are therefore handed over to you for taking necessary legal action against her.
